New Updated Measures To Protect Our Patients and Staff Against Covid-19

To Our Patients:

Eye Physicians of North Houston recognize the importance of protecting our patients and our staff against Covid-19 and other infectious diseases, and we have implemented the following to ensure your safety and to minimize your risk when you need to see your physician:

1. We are screening all patients, visitors, staff, and physicians upon arrival at the clinic. This includes taking temperatures to ensure that everyone present in the clinic is fever-free. If possible, family members and caregivers should stay outside of the clinic (i.e. in their cars) to minimize exposure, unless the patient needs their assistance.
2. Patients and visitors who are not wearing a mask will be offered one, and they shall wear their masks throughout their time at our clinic. You should dispose of your mask after your visit. All staff and physicians are required to wear a mask at all times. Hand sanitizers will be available in all visible clinical and waiting areas for patient use. Waiting chairs will be spaced apart in compliance with social distancing.
3. Our insurance and medical history forms are available on our website at www.1960eye.com under the "Patient Forms" icon on the top right side of the screen. Please take time to fill out these forms prior to coming in for your appointment.
4. If you have a cough, shortness of breath, fever, or been exposed to a COVID-positive patient, please call your primary care physician's office so that she/he can determine where it is most appropriate for you to be seen. If appropriate, your issue could be addressed via a telemedicine visit.

Eye Physicians of North Houston is considered an essential business, and we are here to take care of your medical needs. We do not want your recent or chronic eye problems to go unchecked. Doing so could lead to complications and risk losing your vision.
